## **PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING**

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is additional funding intended to support pupils from low-income families. Our aim at Anton Junior School is a targeted and strategic approach in the use of the Pupil Premium Grant. We aim to support the achievement of children so that they make good progress in literacy and numeracy. We do this by ensuring the best possible delivery of learning experiences in the classroom and having a range of group and individual interventions designed to support those with identified needs.

We offer rich and varied activities designed to engage and motivate pupils, raising their aspirations and creating a positive view of learning. Additional provision for children eligible for Pupil Premium could include:

- extra class based support
- intervention work to accelerate progress of targeted groups or individuals
- learning support to enable children to fully access learning and accelerate progress
- pastoral work which undertakes work to raise self-esteem, extend their personal skills and support children to make appropriate choices (ELSA and Nurture Group)
- access to extra-curricular clubs and enrichment activities

There are additional benefits for children who have registered for Pupil Premium, including subsidies for trips and instrumental lessons.

In order for us to access the funding we need to be able to assess which children are eligible. Parents/carers of children who meet the criteria below may be eligible if parents/carers receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
