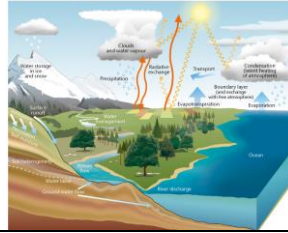

Year 3 Autumn 1 – Water World (The Lake District and Water World)

<p>English</p>	<p>In English, we are using the text Leon and the Place Between to learn about using exciting vocabulary for a setting and character description. We will also be looking at The River and The Rhythm of the Rain to support our writing about rivers and creating our own poems. During the first half term, we will be building on lots of the English skills from KS1 and further developing extending sentences as well as key punctuation and grammar.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of place value up to 3-digit numbers. Then we will be covering addition and subtraction, money and measurement of length, mass and capacity.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>Our topic for Science this half term will be animals and humans. This topic builds on the learning in KS1 about differences in animals and how we categorise them into groups such as mammals and reptiles or hervevores, omnivores and carnivores. We will explore nutrition and look at healthy eating. We will also be learning about muscles and bones in the human body and different functions of the animal body.</p>
<p>Topic</p>	<p>This half term we will be focussing on Geography with our Water Worlds topic. We will be researching the Lake District and other areas formed by galciation as well as how these areas are impacted by tourism. We will also be learning about the water cycle and how to use maps to locate the areas we are learning about.</p>
<p>Other</p>	<p>The children will be learning French at school for the first time. Their first topic will be about greetings. In DT, the children will be learning about castles and the structures that make castles stong. Our RE topic this half term is ‘belonging’ and the children will be looking at the religion Islam. The children will learn about the importance of e-safety in computing and in PE we are doing Yoga and OAA (Outdoor and Adventurous Activities).</p>
