<p>Values</p>	<p>Resilient Being resilient means our children are confident to take risks and challenges in their learning with the ability to overcome barriers they may face.</p> <p>Empowered Being empowered means our children have more confidence when making choices in their learning and when in social situations.</p> <p>Aspirational Being aspirational means our children have a strong desire for success and achievement.</p> <p>Curious Being curious means our children have a thirst for learning new skills and knowledge in different ways throughout the entire Anton curriculum.</p> <p>Honourable Being honourable means our children have respect, honesty and fairness when becoming active members of their school and wider community.</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>We are going to be writing narratives based on Arthur and the Golden Rope for the first half of the term, consolidating our skills from the year. For the latter part of the term we are writing non-chronological reports based around the book, The Hodgheg.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In maths this half term we will be consolidating our maths knowledge for the year, with a particular focus on fractions, multiplication and division, and shape.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>In science this term we are looking at light (a consolidation for Foxes), we will be carrying out a range of experiments and looking at how light travels, reflection and touching on how our eyes process light.</p>
<p>Topic</p>	<p>We are looking at the Iron Age, focusing on chronology and linking the progression of humans from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, we will be looking at how the discovery of iron changed peoples lives, learning about inventions, agriculture and how settlements developed and changed.</p>
<p>Other</p>	<p>In DT we will be developing our peeling and chopping skills, as well as our knowledge of seasonal veg by making vegetable tarts. In music we will be learning about traditional instruments in Indian music. In RE will will be learning about the concept of Courage and how it relates to Islam. In Computing we will be using Scratch to learn how to program short sequences. In PE we will be learning Hockey and practicing general PE skills. In PSHE this term our unit is 'Growing and Changing' we will learn about types of relationships, personal space and privacy, and about some parts of puberty.</p>
