<p>English</p>	<p>In English, our text driver is a beautiful book called 'The Wonder Garden'. The children will use the presentational, organisational and language features within the book to inspire their own writing. They will have the opportunity to create, paint and write about their own wonder garden. They will also write a short diary entry of what it would be like to journey through a wonder garden.</p> 
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths, we are continuing with our revision and preparing the children for SATs and beyond. We will particularly be focusing on long division, shape, FDP, as well as touching on statistics and timetables. The children will continue to work on their arithmetic skills and ability to solve word problems.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>This half term, we will be learning about the concept of light and how it works. We will explore how it travels and deepen our understanding of shadows and their relationship to light.</p>
<p>Topic</p>	<p>Our two wider curriculum focuses this half term will be Geography and DT. In Geography, we will be looking rivers and focusing on fieldwork. We plan to visit the local river and think about the surrounding area and its landuse. In DT we will be focusing on textiles, where we will be making waistcoats and other items for an end of half term fashion show!</p>
