




<p><b>English</b></p>	<p>During Guided Reading, we have started our revision guide to prepare the children for their SATs and to ensure that they are secondary school ready. The children will still have their reading for pleasure slot every Friday and will have the opportunity to visit the library fortnightly. In our writing lessons, we are writing a persuasive speech to encourage children of Anton Junior School to work together to help save our planet. We will be using short film clips on climate change to inspire their writing. <p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>In maths we will be continue to consolidate our arithmetic skills to improve both fluency and pace. We will be learning practising our problem solving skills as well: we will be looking at different ways to solve different problems and we be thinking about why one method may be more efficient than another.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p>	<p>We will be learning about the human circulatory system this half term in science and about the importance of healthy eating and exercise. We will be looking at the different elements of blood and we will carry out experiments to see the effects of exercise on the body.</p>
