




The children will be writing a descriptive story opening and creating dialogue between two characters. During the second half of the term, we will be using the book 'Mythologica' to inspire our writing. The children will create their own Greek mythical creature to then write a non-chronological report about it. In Guided Reading, we will continue our revision focus, in order to prepare the children for SATs and beyond.</p> </div>  </div>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In maths we will be continue to consolidate our arithmetic skills to improve both fluency and pace. We will also be practising some new methods to help us solve bigger problems by learning to break the problems down to help us decide what calculations we need to do to complete the question.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>This half term, we will be celebrating science week by holding a science fair! We are creating an experiment to research and conduct. We will then look forward to doing our experiments with parents on our science afternoon!</p>
<p>Topic</p>	<p>Our two wider curriculum focuses this half term will be geography and art. In geography, we will be looking at the structure of the earth and the varying climates. We will also look at extreme weathers and natural disasters such as earthquakes, tsunamis and tornadoes. In art, we will be studying a range of artists and will explore relief sculptures, before planning and making our own sculptures.</p>
