This meeting was held at Anton Junior School and was held to discuss final planning for the Summer Fayre.

Forthcoming Events

1. Summer Fayre – 19/06/2026

- New Year R vouchers will be for a free turn at one of the games this year rather than lollies as we have the ice cream van instead of selling lollies. Vouchers will be printed on paper and parents can collect from the school office in advance of the fayre. As the New Year R parent information evening will be held after the fayre this year, parents will also be able to collect a voucher on arrival at the fayre – vouchers will be kept at the raffle stall. The Infant school office will send out an email to the new parents to advise them of the date and time of the fayre.
- Layout for the fayre was discussed. Kerri will organise signage. The Junior school building will be locked with toilet access via the reception only.
- Performances: Junior school choir to perform at 3.30pm.
It was discussed that a parent who is a professional singer has offered to perform.
- Raffle prizes – Angela has collated a list of prizes for the raffle and a flyer will be created to advertise the companies who have donated prizes. We do not have the licence to sell tickets in advance so they will only be available on the day. It was discussed that tickets could be available at drop-off and collection to allow any parents not attending the fayre to still take part in the raffle. Payment will be by cash or QR code at £2 a strip. Stacey will order tickets.
- Dress down donations received for raffle prizes will be made up into hampers which will be used as prizes for Spin the Wheel.
- There is alcohol left over from Xmas – it was decided to hold a bottle tombola as well as the adult, children's and teddy tombolas.
- Dress down for tombola prizes is on 12th June. 9 helpers are available to wrap hampers in the Junior school hall after morning drop-off. A staff member from the Junior school will be available at the connecting gate between the schools to allow donations at the Infant school to be brought through.
- Spin the Wheel – prizes will be hampers. Tickets will cost £1.
